

# **Fostering Training Course in Bullous Diseases** 2017

## **Description**

Boullous diseases are the most life-threatening diseases of the skin and mucous membranes. They are rare, and comprise less than 1% of the dermatological patients. The subject blistering or vesicobullous diseases does not cover more than a single section in dermatology textbooks. The gain of experience with patients with a bullous disease is slow in dermatology departments where these diseases are not a special topic. For many bullous diseases are confusing but appeal to the medical competence of the dermatologist. Here we aim to provide a three-day course for learning the workup in diagnosis and treatment of patients with bullous disease, such as pemphigoid, erythema multiforme, vesiculobullous infections, and epidermolysis bullosa.

This EADV Fostering Training Course used as blue print the developed and highly appreciated 'Blister course', that runs annually since 2000 in Groningen for Dutch dermatologists and pathologists. Moreover, the faculty of the Center for Blistering Diseases are the authors of the forthcoming Study Guide Autoimmune Blistering Diseases, which will be handed to the participants as main learning material. The participants will apply the knowledge in the practical histopathology workshop using multiple digital sections of bullous diseases. A step-by-step learning is provided from the clinical and laboratory diagnosis to therapy.

Just like other EADV Fostering courses the friendly and open atmosphere will guarantee an interactive course where participants can also present their cases and approach speakers and fellow participants in an informal way. The venue is the University Medical Center Groningen, the Netherlands, which has received the award as the most beautiful hospital in Europe.
